- There are over 16.2 million orphans in Africa, Asia, Latin America and the Caribbean.
- In 2003, in sub-Saharan Africa 4.6 million children were orphaned by HIV/AIDS. This figure is expected to reach 7.8 million by 2010.
- There are 7.9 million orphans in Asia.
- 16% of households in sub-Saharan Africa are child-led families.

How will wow help?

All of the proceeds from wow will go to SOS Children, a charity currently caring for over 50,000 orphaned and abandoned children in more than 440 inspirational children's villages, in over 125 countries around the world.

SOS Children helps a further half a million people each year by providing schools, medical clinics, community development programmes and emergency relief for vulnerable children and their families. They have already taken in more than 9,000 additional children in emergency child relief centres in the regions hit by the tsunami on Boxing Day.

SOS Children have developed their unique villages over more than 50 years, to give children who have lost everything a loving, secure Future.
